WHEREAS: The Georgia Department of Natural Resources during the month of June 2007 is launching Get Outdoors Georgia, a statewide, ongoing initiative to foster and encourage an interest in health awareness, fitness and outdoors; and

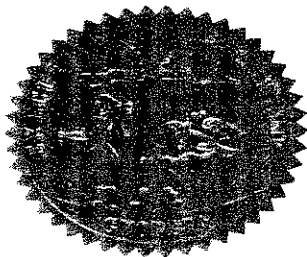
WHEREAS: The mission of the Get Outdoors Georgia initiative focuses on highlighting the link between participating in outdoor recreation and improved health for people of all ages and abilities as well as an emphasis on children's early involvement in nature to establish life-long physical, mental and community benefits; and

WHEREAS: Georgia's Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan for 2008-2013 includes strategic priorities to promote fitness and livability in all Georgia communities, to enhance Georgia's economic vitality through the social, environmental and economic benefits of outdoor recreation and to address the need for conservation and proper use of Georgia's natural resources; and

WHEREAS: President George W. Bush has proclaimed June 2007 as "National Great Outdoors Month." Other outdoor recreation annual events are also occurring in June such as National Trails Day, National Boating and Fishing Week, National Family Recreation Week and National Clean Beaches Week; now

THEREFORE: I, SONNY PERDUE, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 2007 as GEORGIA GREAT OUTDOORS MONTH.
